



COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM

Purpose

The City of Dripping Springs' Parks and Community Services Coyote Kids Nature Camp's mission is to connect kids with nature and the great outdoors. Its Counselor-In-Training program is for campers who are between the ages of 13-15 (by June 1) of their eligible summer. CIT registration is accompanied by an application. Applicants must demonstrate maturity and be able to represent themselves in a manner that exhibits a willingness to take the next step in growth and leadership, as a young person.

We hope that the application process will help introduce skills for the next step, i.e., college applications, job interviews, scholarship applications, etc. introducing them to "down the road" processes. It is our goal to mold strong leaders who understand that dedication and hard work will lead them to better outcomes when making choices. We are looking for mature kids who enjoy mentoring younger kids and can assist camp counselors in creating incredible experiences and memories for Coyote Kids Nature Day campers.

Program Summary

- The one-week Coyote Kids CIT Program is designed to teach nature education skills, leadership, and fun facilitation as well as community and counseling skills, and team building while working with youth 5–12-years of age.
- The Coyote Kids Nature Camp CIT program encourages leadership, problem-solving, responsibility and independence, which is essential in their futures, both at Camp and life at home. CITs participate in creating, supporting, and leading some camp activities while enjoying the fun of camp.
- A successful participant will have shown themselves to be enthusiastic, dedicated, hard-working and devoted to the Coyote Kids Nature Camp Mission.
- The CIT Leader will use the dynamics of shared experiences and responsibility to bond the participants. CITs will be visible at camp as leaders in CIT skits, daily hikes, activities, games and at our camp wrap up campfire on Fridays.
- It is important to understand CITs are campers and not on staff. They are expected to demonstrate excellent behavior and be a positive role model for the campers and camp staff. They will be held accountable for any inappropriate behavior.

Application Process

- Register for the Summer 2021 Coyote Kids Camp week of choice and pay the fee. Registration is now open.
- Registrations are accepted throughout the summer. Once the CIT camper is registered, they will receive a CIT "Application" google form. This allows the Camp Director to get to know them better prior to the start of their camp session(s) and gauge which Coyote Pack they should be paired with.
